## Site #1: Monterey Bay Academy

- 3, 4, and 5 day program options
- Program size: up to 35 students
- Group size average: 15 students per instructor

  - Watershed hike in Elkhorn Slough
  - Mini research submarine construction & deep sea studies
  - A town hall-style debate on marine issues
  - Tidepool explorations
  - Seymour Discovery Center or Monterey Bay Aquarium visit (additional fee may apply)

## Site #2: Camp St. Francis

- 3 day, 2 night residential program
- Program size: up to 90 students
- Group size average: 15 students per instructor
- Includes program transportation, room & board, journals and student t-shirts.

  - Night Beach Walk & Campfire
  - Squid Dissection
  - Plankton Labs
  - Invertebrate Surveys
  - Beach Exploration
  - Ocean Currents Lab
